MAIN RING SCHEDULE: 8AM START

TRAIL OPEN FROM: 8AM to 11:00AM

Classes are \$10 or Show all day for \$40 per horse/rider combination.

Family fee show all day for \$80 (immediate family members only)

Trail Divisions: Trail classes will be held in the mini/3rd ring from 8am to 11am. Patterns will be posted.

- 1T: Walk Pattern
- 2T: Walk, Jog Pattern
- 3T: Walk, Jog, Lope Pattern
- 4T: In-Hand Walk Pattern (open to all size horses)
- 5T: In-Hand Walk/Trot Pattern (open to all size horses)

Itty Bitty Jumpers: Open to all riders. Jumps will be set at 2'0" Time allowed will be marked on the course for the division. Courses will be posted.

Low Hunter: Open to all horses and ponies of any age. Judged on performance, manners, soundness, and way of going. Show both ways of the ring. Courses will be posted.

Pleasure Horse/Pony: Open to all horses/ponies and riders of any age. Judged on horse/pony's performance, manners, soundness, and suitability as a pleasure mount. Show both ways of the ring at a walk, trot, and canter.

9. Bridle Path Hack- 2 fences (cross rails set at 18")

Pairs: Open to riders of all ages. Open to all horses and ponies of any age. Rules can be found in the rules and regulations. Course will be posted.

****Hunter Derby:** Sponsored by Sally Glassman. Open to all horses/ponies and rider of any age. Rules can be found in the rules and regulations. Courses will be posted. Entry fee \$20.00 (in addition to the flat fee for the day). **Cash payout** 1st place \$75.00, 2nd place \$50, and 3rd \$25.00.

11. Derby 2'3"-2'6"

****BRC Gambler's Choice:** Sponsored by Sally Glassman. Open to all horses/ponies and riders of any age. Fences will range from 18" crossrails to 3'6". The rules can be found in the rules & regulations. Entry fee \$20.00 (in addition to the flat fee for the day). **Cash payout** 1st place \$75.00, 2nd place \$50, and 3rd \$25.00.

12. BRC Gambler's Choice

Minis: (will be held in the mini/3rd ring) Open to all miniature horses/ponies and handlers of any age. Courses/Patterns will be posted.

Leadline (English/Western): Riders 9 and under. Children 3 years and under must have a side walker. To be judged on the rider's hands, seat, and control of mount.

Adult Leadline (English/Western): Open to all adults who do not show or lesson regularly (Such as: moms, dads, significant others, etc.) To be judged on rider's hand, seat, and control of mount.

19. Walk
20. Walk/Trot (Jog)

Stock Type (English/Western): (Quarter Horses, Paints, and Appaloosas) Open to any age rider and horse/ponies of any age. Judged on breed type, suitability, also judged on the rider's hands, seat, and control of mount.

21. Walk, Trot (Jog) Pleasure
22. Walk, Trot (Jog) Equitation
23. Walk, Trot (Jog), Canter (Lope)

Western Pleasure: Open to riders of any age and horses/ponies of any age. To be judged on manners, performance, soundness and suitability of mount. May be asked to back and extend gait.

26. Walk, Jog- rail work at judge's discretion
