**MINI/TRAIL RING: 8AM START**

**Classes run in number order**

Classes are \$10 each or Show all day for \$50 per horse/rider combination.

Family fee show all day for \$100 (immediate family members only)

## Mini/Trail Ring 8AM Start

**Trail Divisions:** Trail classes will be held in the mini/trail ring and run in number order. Patterns will be posted.

- 1T: Walk Pattern
- 2T: Walk, Jog Pattern
- 3T: Walk, Jog, Lope Pattern
- 4T: In-Hand Walk Pattern (open to all size horses)
- 5T: In-Hand Walk/Trot Pattern (open to all size horses)

**Minis:** (will be held in the mini/trail ring) Open to all miniature horses/ponies and handlers of any age. Courses/Patterns will be posted. To start at the conclusion of the trail classes.

- 6T. Showmanship
- 7T. Timed Jumper
- 8T. Timed Pattern - Mystery
- 9T. The Mini "B" in memory of George Burgess

## Main Ring 8AM Start

**Itty Bitty Jumpers:** Open to all riders. Jumps will be set at 2'0" Time allowed will be marked on the course for the division. Courses will be posted.

1. Itty Bitty (Table 2b)
2. Itty Bitty (Power and Speed)
3. Itty Bitty (Speed Class)

**\*\*BRC Gambler's Choice:** Open to all horses/ponies and riders of any age. Fences will range from 18" crossrails to 3'6". The rules can be found in the rules & regulations. Entry fee \$20.00 (in addition to the flat fee for the day). **Cash payout** 1<sup>st</sup> place 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 30%, and 3<sup>rd</sup> 20% of half of the entry fees collected.

4. BRC Gambler's Choice

### To Start after the conclusion of the mini classes

**Low Hunter:** Open to all horses and ponies of any age. Judged on performance, manners, soundness, and way of going. Show both ways of the ring. Courses will be posted.

5. O/F 2'0"
6. O/F 2'0"
7. Under Saddle

**Pleasure Horse/Pony:** Open to all horses/ponies and riders of any age. Judged on horse/pony's performance, manners, soundness, and suitability as a pleasure mount. Show both ways of the ring at a walk, trot, and canter.

8. Walk/Trot
9. Walk/Trot/Canter
10. Bridle Path Hack- 2 fences (cross rails set at 18")

**Pairs:** Open to riders of all ages. Open to all horses and ponies of any age. Rules can be found in the rules and regulations. Course will be posted.

11. O/F Pairs 2'0"

**\*\*Hunter Derby:** Open to all horses/ponies and rider of any age. Rules can be found in the rules and regulations. Courses will be posted. Entry fee \$20.00 (in addition to the flat fee for the day). **Cash payout** 1<sup>st</sup> place 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 30%, and 3<sup>rd</sup> 20% of half of the entry fees collected.

12. Derby 2'3"-2'6"

**Leadline (English/Western):** Riders 9 and under. Children 3 years and under must have a side walker. To be judged on the rider's hands, seat, and control of mount.

- 14. Walk/Trot (Jog)

**Adult Leadline (English/Western):** Open to all adults who do not show or lesson regularly (Such as: moms, dads, significant others, etc.) To be judged on rider's hand, seat, and control of mount.

- 15. Walk
- 16. Walk/Trot (Jog)

**Stock Type (English/Western):** (Quarter Horses, Paints, and Appaloosas) Open to any age rider and horse/ponies of any age. Judged on breed type, suitability, also judged on the rider's hands, seat, and control of mount.

- 17. Walk, Trot (Jog) Pleasure
- 18. Walk, Trot (Jog) Equitation
- 19. Walk, Trot (Jog), Canter (Lope)

**Western Pleasure:** Open to riders of any age and horses/ponies of any age. To be judged on manners, performance, soundness and suitability of mount. May be asked to back and extend gait.

- 20. Walk, Jog
- 21. Walk, Jog- Advanced
- 22. Walk, Jog, Lope

**Games:**
